The Department of Sociology and Anthropology announces a tenure-track opening for an urban sociologist, beginning in the Fall of 2009. A PhD in sociology is required at the time of appointment. We prefer candidates at the advanced Assistant Professor rank, although applications will also be considered at the Associate level with tenure. We are especially keen to consider applicants with expertise in quantitative research methods; applicants whose knowledge extends to such areas of concentration as race and ethnicity, globalization, or social inequality are also eagerly sought. Northeastern University is a large, private institution located in the heart of Boston and whose institutional mission has urban engagement at its core. The Department is a strong and growing unit with a well-established PhD program, whose faculty are committed to excellence in research, teaching, and critical scholarship. The Department hosts multiple Centers and enjoys numerous interdisciplinary linkages, prominent among which is the Center for Urban and Regional Policy. Women and members of historically excluded groups are especially encouraged to apply.
