



Presenter Guide

Bring your presentations on a USB drive: It is important to plan ahead and bring your presentation on a USB drive so that it can be loaded on the presider's (or another session volunteer's) laptop. While all of the breakout rooms in the Sheraton will have WiFi available it is a good idea to bring your presentation on a USB drive and/or send to the presider of your session for a backup.

Keep to your time limits: Our sessions are 75 minutes, and most paper sessions include 3 to 5 presenters. We recommend planning ahead and keeping your paper within the following timelines:

- 15 minutes for sessions with either 3 or 4 papers
- 12 minutes for sessions with 5 papers

We have asked presiders to keep presenters to their time limits and cut them off and move to the next paper should they go over. Reach out to your session organizer or the program coordinators with questions.
